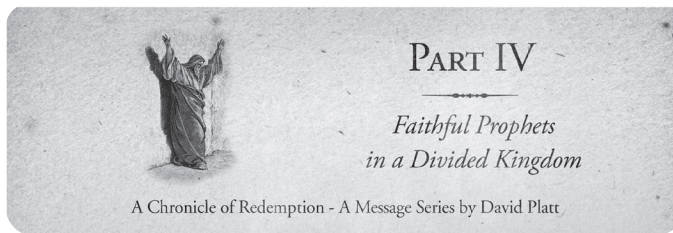
- Prophets in Israel (the Northern Kingdom)...
