



## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

### QUESTION 1

Jesus told us to make disciples of “all nations” (Matthew 28:19). What does “nations” refer to, and how is this different from the way we use the term?

### QUESTION 2

Is God’s desire for all nations to know Him a concept that is unique to Jesus’ ministry? What examples/passages in the Old Testament indicate God’s desire for all peoples to know Him?

### QUESTION 3

Respond to the following statement: “I don’t need to worry about ‘all nations’ because God hasn’t called me to be a missionary.”

### QUESTION 4

Both unreached peoples and unbelievers in your community are separated from Christ. What’s the difference between these two groups? Why must we try to reach both groups?

What are some practical ways listed in this sermon for you to be involved in reaching the nations?
